What about MacOSX computers and for users who are not admins nor do they have individual Apple ID's? How do I manage this with Casper?

You can use Casper Suite to install software on Mac computers for users who are not local admins. Installing software from the Mac App Store requires an AppleID; if the user does not have an AppleID, you can use Casper Suite to package and deploy the apps on their behalf. (Note that it will still require an AppleID, but this could belong to the IT admin rather than the user)

How can I authorize my users to use the App store but only for Apps in the App Store that they're authorized to see/use? Thus using Self Service to update, for example?

You can set restrictions on the App Store based on age level. You cannot restrict the App Store based on specific apps.

Does JAMF support managed distribution of OS X Mavericks apps purchased through the iTunes VPP? I know you do for iOS 7?

Yes. Casper Suite offers VPP Managed Distribution for iOS and OS X apps purchased through VPP.

Apple and other App developers are starting to include DRM in their App Store apps. How is this able to be used within Casper for app deployment?

The Casper Suite does not alter or interfere with how Apple or app developers chose to manage digital rights or restrictions. The Casper Suite can be used to distribute any app that is available in the App Store or any in-house app that has been licensed for distribution; however, rights and restrictions of

the apps themselves are dictated by the app developer and by Apple.
